Grid Size: 150W x 100H
Design Area: 10.71" x 7.14" (150 x 100 stitches)

Legend:

□ [2] DMC 5200 snow white ■ [2] DMC 304 christmas red - md

***Please note the amount of yarn listed is estimated by using a size H needle.**

150 stitches by 200 Rows

Red - 14 oz
White -35 oz

This pattern was designed for single crochet, Tapestry or Tunisian/Afghan method.
Approximate sizes:

- 52" x 60" worsted weight, size I hook, gauge, 16 stitches by 16 rows = 4 sq inches.
- 30" x 40" sport weight, size G hook, gauge, 20 stitches by 20 rows = 4 inches.
- 33.3" x 26" baby weight, size F hook, gauge, 18 stitches by 32 rows = 4 inches.

Add stitches evenly before and after pattern to enlarge width, starting foundation chain; add rows evenly before and after pattern to enlarge height.

Using Single Crochet - each colored square is equal to one single crochet. Chain the amount of stitches indicated on graph, chain 1, and turn. Read graph for single crochet from right to left for right side and left to right for wrong side. Foundation chain: number of blocks in pattern, starting at bottom right, chain one as first sc, and turn sc in second ch. Continue following pattern until all rows are completed.

Using Tapestry Crochet - One colored square equals one sc.

Using Tunisian or Afghan - stitch - read from right to left for all rows. Each color square is equal to one afghan or Tunisian stitch.

Using Cross Stitch method - Start and finish afghan in background color. Following the graph pattern, each square represents one cross-stitch. Stitch corner to corner on right side of afghan, cross over in the same direction for each stitch. Do not pull tight as afghan may pucker.

Using Filet Crochet Method - See instructions included. Each colored block is equal to 1 mesh (4 double) crochets.

- 112.75" x 158" Worsted Weight, size I hook.
- 90.2" x 99" Sport Weight, size G hook.
- 100" x 86" Baby/Fingering, size F hook.

For Filet crochet: one colored square on the graph equals 4 double crochets, each open square is equal to 1 double crochet 2 chains. 1 double crochet. All are colored on this pattern. Read graph for Filet from right to left for right side and left to right for wrong side.

Filet Crochet: Starting at the bottom of the pattern, CHAIN 451, Chain 3 to turn, which will count as first dc of first row. DC in 5th ch from hook. DC in next 2 chains to complete bottom right solid mesh/square of pattern ch 3 and turn. Continue following the pattern right to left for right side left to right for wrong side. Continue following pattern until all rows are complete.

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
